4) What aspects of this database/training session would be useful to staff in a clinical setting?

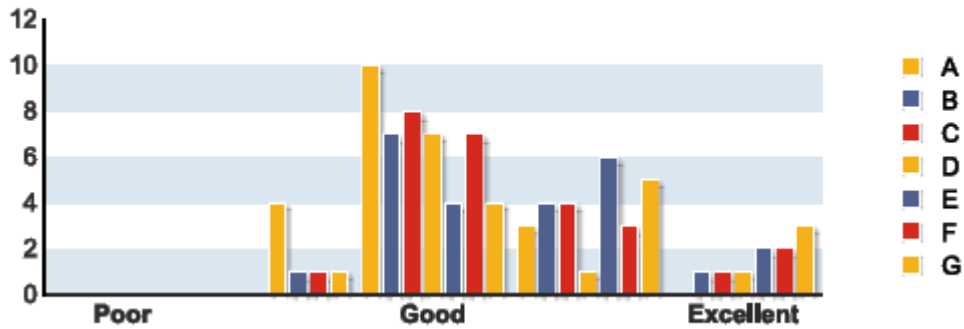
- Most
